



The History of Jeep Club SA

When and why was the club founded?

Jeep Club RSA was founded in May 2005, so we are celebrating our 10 Year Anniversary this year. The Jeep Club RSA was created with the support of The Chrysler Jeep and Dodge Division Daimler Chrysler South Africa as an extension of the Brand, offering 4x4 activities to current and new Jeep Owners. In 2009 at the AGM the club was renamed Jeep Club South Africa and operated in Gauteng and KZN. In 2013 the Jeep Club SA became a national club with representation in three major regions, Gauteng, Western Cape and KZN. Jeep Club South Africa operates to provide current members with closed events which consist of weekends away as well as social events. Occasionally the club will organise an "open" event to accommodate other 4x4 enthusiasts, friends and clubs with vehicles other than Jeeps. You must have a Jeep to be a member to Jeep Club SA.

Who participates in the events? (mostly men? women? families? younger/older? beginners/experienced?)

Being a social family club, the events are planned in such a way that the needs and wishes of the whole family are addressed. The majority of the Jeep drivers are men with the women growing in participation within the club. Our outings cater for the new Jeep owner as they are positioned with an experienced driver when on route to ensure they have a wow experience and are left with the exhilarating feeling of when do we do the next outing.

Do you welcome new members and do you cater for beginners?

With the close relationship in place with Fiat SA all New Jeep owners in South Africa automatically become Jeep Club SA members for a year and are invited to take part in Jeep outings within their region. Other Jeep owners are also invited to join the club with an annual membership fee of R500.00 a year. National events are also created to allow the Jeep owners to come together and enjoy the camaraderie of the Jeep family. Beginners are always welcome to attend formalised training days provided for the new Jeep owner to understand how the technology of their Jeep works before venturing out.

The Origin of Jeep Club SA

Although the Jeep Club SA in its current form is celebrating its 10th (tenth) year in existence (2005 - 2015) - the original SA Jeep Club was established in September 1976. In order to accommodate other vehicle manufacturers and obtain sponsorships for events, the club had to change its name and since 2003 a "SA Jeep Club Division" within the original club had to keep the Jeep Club alive - specifically catering for the needs of Jeep enthusiasts. During April 2005 some of these Jeep enthusiasts decided that this arrangement was no longer satisfactory and with the support of Chrysler Jeep South Africa, established the "new" independent "Jeep Club RSA". During the years many changes and adjustments were made to the structure of the Club, eventually resulting in the National Jeep Club South Africa as structured today.
